

Show Dates:

The Holidays Festival in Dalton is now accepting applications for the 49th Annual Arts & Crafts Show to be held December 6th and 7th, 2025.

Address:

The show will be held in the Dalton High School, 177 North Mill Street. Dalton is located midway between Massillon and Wooster at the intersection of US Route 30 and State Route 94, only 30 minutes from Akron or Canton. Motels are plentiful between Canton and Wooster.

Show Hours:

Saturday 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Sunday 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Setup/Breakdown:

Setup will be Saturday, December 6th at 6:30 a.m. and Sunday, December 7th at 9 a.m. Vendors may not leave early either day, and must not breakdown their spots until the close of the show on Sunday. *LIMITED* help is provided during the initial setup Saturday morning. The local boy-scout troop volunteers to assist vendors during setup, and breakdown.

Check-in:

Exhibitors are **REQUIRED** to check in **PRIOR** to setting up their booths. Important information is provided with your registration envelope.

Displays:

You may leave your display up overnight, but it will be at your own risk. You <u>must</u> keep your booth open <u>both</u> days and not close early or you will be refused from future shows.

Booth Rental Rate:

\$55.00 for each 8ft by 10ft space. Booth location is based on a <u>FIRST COME FIRST SERVE</u> <u>BASIS</u>. Application deadline is November 1st, 2025 **or** until all booth space is filled. You may pay for your current booth space during the show for the following year.

Your application must be accompanied by the rental fee payment. NO BOOTHS WILL BE RESERVED WITHOUT FULL PAYMENT! Checks should be made out to *Dalton Holidays Festival*. The Dalton Holidays Festival will <u>NOT</u> give refunds in the event of severe winter weather. NO REFUNDS after November 1st, 2025.



Booth Confirmation:

Unless an exhibitor attended the show the prior year, approval by a jurying committee is needed before any application is considered granted. Approved applicants will receive an email confirmation with booth location, once the application has been processed. We review many applications, and judging can take weeks, so please be patient. Those not accepted will have their fee returned in full in the USPS and may not include an explanation why.

Photos of your goods must accompany all new applications. You may use camera photos, computer prints on paper or photo paper. Due to the increased cost of printer ink, we will no longer be accepting digital photos, or texting photos to a tablet or phone. Our jurying committee must review applications between multiple persons, and sharing electronic devices is not possible during this process. If you want your photos returned, state so on the application, and they will be returned to you during show registration and check-in, please ask for them.

Placement:

Booth(s) will be assigned on a first come first served basis after the application has been reviewed and accepted by the jurying committee. You may wish to look at the floor layout and then indicate the number(s) of the booth(s) you prefer. We will make every attempt to accommodate your needs. If the space you wish is already taken, we will assign a location that is available.

Third Party Vendors will be accepted, spaces are first come first serve with allowance of only one vendor per category type.

The show management will do its best to separate exhibitors working in the same media. <u>The Dalton Holidays Festival reserves the right to alter the location of exhibitors or booths in the floor plan, if in the best interest of the show, or for any other unforeseen situations that may arise.</u>

Any exhibitor failing to occupy space contracted for is not relieved of the obligation of paying the full rental of such exhibit space as provided for in the signed contract. If not occupied by the 9:00 a.m. opening of the show, such space may be possessed by show management for such purposes as it may see fit, in which case the exhibitor shall pay the full rental for such space. Show management reserves the right to re-rent such space without notice to the original exhibitor.



Acceptable Types:

Accepted:

- 1) Only original, handcrafted items made by the person(s) selling them.
- 2) Original artwork hand drawn on the premises, such as caricatures, and or portraits.

Limited Accepted:

- 1. A limited number of 3rd Party sellers
- 2. Applications accepted by first come first serve.
- 3. Only one vendor per category type accepted.

Non-Accepted:

- 1) Food of any sort meant to be eaten by people (humans), including ingredients in boxes or jars.
- 2) Manufactured and imported items, to be resold.
- 3) Products that are written, such as books, which have been commercially reproduced with an automated press, and or binding machine.
- 4) Audio media, which has been produced and copied for use on digital or mechanical players.
- 5) Weapons of any kind including knives.

If an item in question is not listed here, please inquire about the item you are selling to verify its eligibility in the show as a hand made item.

If show Management wishes to ask the removal of items or entire display for any reason(s), it reserves the right to do so without refund. The festival sells its own food products; food products or items containing food to be eaten by people are not permitted. Exhibitors shall not sublet (re-rent) any or all contracted space without prior management approval. No open flame or incense candles will be burned as per *Fire Marshal* regulations. Small children are not permitted in the booths with exhibitors.

Tables and chairs:

Each vendor is responsible for providing their own tables and chairs.

Booths:

Exhibitors may rent up to two (2) spots which either connect (adjoin) or are separate from each other. No more than a total of two (2) spots per exhibitor may be rented at any given time. Bring padding for any sharp display stands, tables, chairs, etc. which might harm the floor covering. Exhibitors are liable for any damage caused to building, floors, walls, and/or floor coverings, or to other exhibitors' property. Exhibitors should not apply paint, lacquer, adhesive, or other coating to building floors or walls. Do not use tape on any painted surfaces, tape can damage walls, and be difficult to remove. We ask all our vendors be respectful of the space they are renting for the weekend. All displays must be self-supporting, and walls should be no higher than 8 feet. We require that all tables be covered at the front and sides of the table.



Electricity is very limited:

If you must have electric, please note on your contract and the reason for your request. Those that will need electric must provide their own electric cords (50 feet or longer) and tape the cords down with duct tape. Electric is available for outside wall booths only.

Identification:

It is very important, label your products, provide business cards or hang a sign to identify your booth's name.

Drawings/Contests:

Drawing and raffles are forbidden, except by the Show Management.

Eating, drinking and smoking:

There will be food and drink served in the school cafeteria. No alcohol is permitted in the building or on the D.H.S. grounds. No smoking of any kind, including vaping and/or e-cigarettes, in the buildings, no exceptions.

Dress/Costumes:

Exhibitors are asked to dress in the Christmas spirit, however no Santa suits please, since Santa will visit the festival on Saturday and Sunday.

Music:

Vendors may not play music at their booths; the festival will play music through the school's music speaker system.

First Aid:

If anyone cuts himself or herself or needs medical attention, we ask that you notify the information table. We have a first aid kit and will contact the local authorities as the need arises.


Emergencies:
